

# It's raining Light

"It's raining Light" is a Light Installation comprised for (at least) 9 umbrellas which hang upside down and display different light patterns, sometimes behaving as a group, sometimes individually. The installation can be set up in interior spaces, natural environments such as parks, streets and others. The configuration is very flexible and adaptable, and it is also reasonable easy to produce more pieces to install the piece on a bigger scale.

It is possible to include in the installation a beautiful soundtrack created to enhance the installation; a soundscape which includes atmospheric sounds and digitally modified droplets sounds.

## Technical requirements:

- Regular electricity connection.
- The installation requires something to be hung from. We are capable of creating a net of rope in order to do so, but still we need to be able to fix these ropes somewhere, like trees, poles, or other stable structures.
- The installation is waterproof and has already been tested in winter under rain and snow without inconvenience.
- A cherry picker might be necessary for the buildup of this installation depending on the circumstances previously explained.

Setup time: 1 day

Dismantling time: 2 hours
